For the second consecutive year, Pastor Bob and his staff coordinated a crusade June 19-26 on the Pillatre campus. The HCM crew set up a big, covered stage on the basketball court complete with speaker towers and lights.



The theme was from 1 Timothy 2:5, "There is only one mediator". It was rocking and amazing! Our staff hired a revival group from Port au Prince and Gonaives to come in and do a music and preaching sessions every night from 5-10 pm. Many leaders and churches in the community closed their nighttime activities to join us. We estimate that there were over 2300 people present each night! 61 young people accepted Christ during the

week. Praise God! So many young people were delivered from demonic possession during that week. We ended with our annual harvest service in the

morning, a great concert, and fellowship moment with Pastor Bob's family.

We are so grateful to the HCM board of directors, and we are praying for God's support to see if this event can be coordinated every year. Our God is on the move! God has provided and we trust His hands.
