



Year in Review

As we reflect on 2022, it has been another challenging year in Haiti. Government instability, fuel shortages, uncertainty, inflation, and gang violence have been the headlines for Haiti. While the news continues to paint a picture of despair, we know that God continues to provide and be near to all His people. We continue to be thankful for all our in-country staff and pastors, as well as their families. They continue to do God's work and serve the ministry so well.

It is not all bad news. Even in the midst of challenges, we have witnessed such wonderful news and growth this year. Here are just a few of the highlights from 2022:

- Difou started an education and feeding program. These two very important programs fill a gap in the area that will continue to expand HCM's impact in meeting physical and spiritual needs.
- Rivière Sable has a new church pavilion built. This church has continued to grow every year in mission and outreach to the community. The daycare hosted on the property helps to meet education and nutrition needs for kids in the community.
- Wensky Fleurissant, a graduate of our leadership program at Pillatre, is hired to administer the feeding and education programs at our churches. Wensky and his team teach Bible stories, leadership lessons, make sure the food is cooked, and the children fed well. The children in the program are monitored to see how they are growing and gaining weight.
- Boukan Michel is blessed by the staff at Welcome Home Haiti with an upgraded church pavilion. Over the course of two days, the WHH team strengthened the existing frame and then added a steel roof. Bringing in the materials to this very remote church was extremely difficult as there is no vehicular route to take.
- Pillatre hosted its second annual revival. Thousands come to worship and hear messages focused on 1 Timothy 2:5. Sixty-one people accepted Christ as their savior over the course of the week. Praise God!
- Difou hosted its first revival. An estimated one thousand plus people come to hear messages from Ephesians 1:22 and worship with music. Thirty-six people make the decision to follow Jesus during the time of the revival. Another Praise God moment!
- Through our partnership with Midwest Food Bank, we are able to share extra food with the community and churches of HCM. More than 300 families are given food during a time of extreme food scarcity.
