On July 7, 2023, a youth delegation of 14 people from Pillatre Christian Church accompanied the president and the



vice-president of the youth association to go to Boukan Michele. Boukan Michele is in a very remote location which is a two-hour drive and a four-hour walk to reach. The goal of this recent visit was to encourage the teachers at the school of 150 impoverished kids. This school has no roof and seat structure, no uniform support, no food like our other schools in the ministry. We are thankful God has placed some good Samaritans in our community to support when they can.

The team brought some food and peanuts from Pillatre inventory and cooked a good meal for

them. They played with them and taught them about "Let's love each other". Our church members have sent some used clothes and other additional items for them to use. Our coordinator of this delegation, Jacky Mercius said: "this trip has brought some great experiences to our young people and has encouraged them to serve others as they follow Christ's path and Pastor Bob leadership."
